



a ridiculously easy way to create websites!

Weebly is a free web building tool that virtually anyone can use to create quality, professional looking websites, blogs, news reels, etc...

To create a weebly page, simply sign up by linking your facebook account, or create a new account from scratch at www.weebly.com

Follow the prompts, and you're on your way to having a page that looks like it was created by a web genius! By selecting the "type" of page you want, you will be given various options in layout. I chose an "education" page and was given the option to utilize forms and survey links. Of course, you could have all the bells & whistles with a paid account, but what teacher wants to pay out of pocket for another resource for the classroom!

Your weebly page will always be free, but for ease of use, I recommend using a url that is universal; pick a web address that you can use for a variety of classes so that you don't have to keep track of multiple pages. For example, use something like www.history101.weebly.com rather than www.history101period3.weebly.com. If you have different content that you want visible to different classes, you can customize that in a snap through your user portal.

Make it:

- www.weebly.com
- Sign up (enter name, email & password)
- Choose a theme from the gobs of choices & colors listed
- Pick a domain name ie: myblog (in order to keep your site free, the file extension of .weebly.com will be added. You can opt to buy a domain name if you wish too).
- Choose the "type" of site you are creating ie: education, blog, personal, etc.
- Using the tools at the top of your screen drag the items you would like to use for your site.
- Add pages through the "pages" tab.
- All of your design options are located at the top of the toolbar.
- Always save your changes as you build & once you have a page the way you want, PUBLISH IT!

Now spend at least an hour messing with every detail and element on the site. You are now a webmaster, congratulations!
